LOCAL MUSICIANS & RECORDING ARTISTS FROM ALL GENRES ARE INVITED TO SUBMIT CD'S FOR PLAYBACK ON SAN FRANCISCO'S CABLE CHANNEL 29

Are you a San Francisco-based musician, band, singer or performer?

Would you like to build your local audience and have your original audio compositions reach upwards of 600,000 local cable viewers in every neighborhood across the City & County of San Francisco?

As part of the station's community bulletin board and station breaks, Access San Francisco, operators of Cable Channel 29, are pleased to present audio CDs featuring San Francisco resident-artists. Station breaks occur between scheduled programming for approximately 90 seconds. The community bulletin board is cablecast weekdays from 10:00-10:30am and from 3:30-4:00pm. Selected CDs are played on Cable Channel 29 for a minimum of one week. They become the property of Access San Francisco and remain apart of the station's audio library for ongoing playback as scheduling allows.

To submit a music CD for playback:

- ❖ You must compose and perform original music only that you own the copyright to.
- ❖ You bring a copy of your CD to the station in person with proof of residency (current phone or utility bill). You complete our CD/Music Release form, also available at the station.
- ❖ Proof of residency is required to prove that residents who made the work and have rights to it are submitting the work and granting us permission to play it on air.
- ❖ All submissions must be made in person. Submissions are not received by post.
- ❖ Station's Open Hours are Tuesday thru Friday, 3:00pm–11:00pm & Saturday, 11:00am–7:00pm
